In many dialysis clinics, treatments are still performed using multiple individually packaged disposable items such as gauze, syringes, gloves, and other consumables.

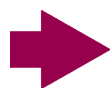

Why Use Dialysis Procedure Sets?

All required materials are preassembled in one package. This eliminates the need for nurses to gather and open multiple individual items, significantly **reducing preparation time for each treatment**.



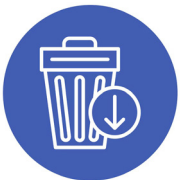
2. Consistency in Clinical Procedures

Our Dialysis Sets can be fully customized according to the protocols and preferences of each clinic. Depending on the procedure, a set may include many medical devices... Some examples are:

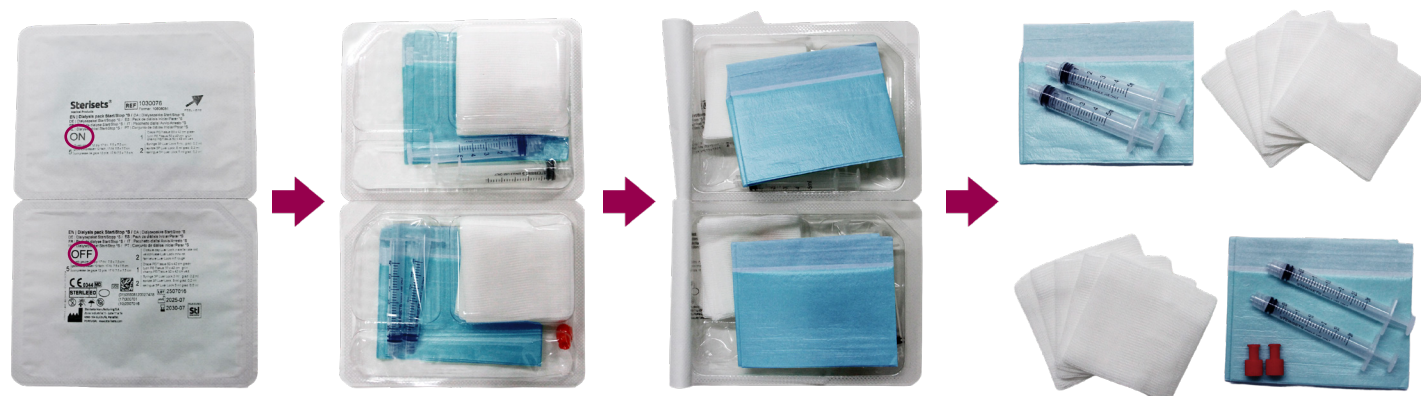
